Chairwoman's report by Maren Malling:

- KIF is still relevant
- Social media followers are growing
- Maren shared some numbers on student, permanent, semi-permanent staff intake and retention in the university
 - Issue: No official published numbers so Maren went to each Danish university's webpage
- Admission of young women
 - Fewer than men
 - 25% of the total physics student intake
 - Getting back to academic work after maternity leave is very difficult.
- By 2030, the goal is to have 30% permanent staff - NBI, KU
- Maren presented

 - Shared numbers on our social media followers and content - interviews, quotes on Instagram etc.
 - Budget
 - Grant status
- Input from the audience:
 - Most women go to industry after their PhD because the support system
 - We should start at the secondary school level to increase student intake
 - Girls and young women don't feel included in a male-dominated environment - the perception becomes it's a lonely place with nerdy boys, beer and boisterous stuff.
